Overview of the Current Decade: 2020-2029

- It's a NEW season!
- Hebrew Calendar PEY (decade of the mouth)





- The word PEY means "mouth" used in word, expression, vocalization, speech and breath.
- Some PEY Words for this season (next decade): Earthquake, Refugee, Rebellion, Believe, Shaking, Revolt, Fear, Shift. Things are going to happen so quickly!
- This is a time of deliverance from your enemies, breaking of curses, blessings, fruitful increase, Holy Ghost and Fire, Miracles, Signs and Wonders.

- Pay attention to what you <u>SAY</u> during this decade! Be alert. Be watchful.
- We must discern when to speak and when to be quiet.
- **Joshua 1:8** (**NKJV**) This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

A Closer Look at Speaking:

- It was by and through the word of God, that God spoke the entire creation and the universe into existence. (1 John 1:1-5)
- Habakkuk 2:1 (KJV) I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what he will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reproved.
- We have the authority to speak to, not talk to.

- **Job 22:28 (KJV)** Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee: and the light shall shine upon thy ways.
- We must understand that we are "speaking spirits". Spirit words cause things in the spirit to shift. It is time for the speaking spirits to invade the earth; because the Lord has given us dominion.
- We have to bring voice to what God has spoken in the realm of the spirit. When you speak, your words register in a different realm. We register according to the word of God.
- Notice how God spoke during creation; then he turned things over to Adam to speak and name the animals. We were created to **re present** (represent) God. (Genesis 1 & 2)



LIST SOME NATURAL FUNCTIONS OF THE MOUTH: Eating, Tasting, Drinking, Speaking, Breathing ...

- Everything has a <u>unique</u> voice for its <u>unique</u> purpose. Example: fowl, lion, dog, pig etc.
- You do not have to be present at a certain place to effect there; because the authority is in your words. (Matthew 8:5-13).
- Your mouth is to be used for legislation, prayer, warfare, intercession, praise and worship. You cannot afford to be silent in this season!
- **Jeremiah 1:9** (**NLT**) Then the Lord reached out and touched my mouth and said, "Look, I have put my words in your mouth!
- Which voice will rule you in this season?
- **Isaiah 55:11 (NLT)** It is the same with my word. I send it out, and it always produces fruit. It will accomplish all I want it to, and it will prosper everywhere I send it.
- You do not have to be a Prophet to prophesy as the meanings differ. You have the power to prophesy to your situation, like Elijah prophesying to the dry bones. (Ezekiel 37:1-14)
- Fast from negative speaking. Change your thought patterns. We have to learn or train ourselves to speak positive.

Negative Example – I am feeling very sick Positive Example – I speak healing to my body in Jesus Name

• **Proverbs 18:20 (NLT)** Wise words satisfy like a good meal; the right words bring satisfaction.

- Proverbs 21:23 (NLT) Watch your tongue and keep your mouth shut, and you will stay out of trouble.
- Do not attach yourself to people who are speaking negative things. Also, be careful about "silly" jokes that people make with you.
- Pray in the spirit and things will shift.
- God wants you to have this NEW season and everything it brings!
- WATCH your emotions. WATCH what you say over yourself, your spouse, your children, your family/bloodline.
- Psalm 19:14 (KJV) Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O Lord, my strength, and my redeemer.

Scriptures to Speak Over Your Life and Others:

We must not just read, study and meditate on God's word, we need to SPEAK it.

Psalm 141:3 (NIV) Set a guard over my mouth, LORD; keep watch over the door of my lips.

Proverbs 10:19 (NLT) Too much talk leads to sin. Be sensible and keep your mouth shut. The words of the godly are like sterling silver; the heart of a fool is worthless.

Proverbs 10:31 (NLT) The mouth of the godly person gives wise advice, but the tongue that deceives will be cut off.

Proverbs 12:14 (NLT) Wise words bring many benefits, and hard work brings rewards.

Proverbs 12:18 (NIV) Some people make cutting remarks, but the words of the wise bring healing.

Proverbs 13:3 (NLT) Those who control their tongue will have a long life; opening your mouth can ruin everything.

Proverbs 15:1 (ESV) A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.

Proverbs 15:2 (CEV) Words of wisdom come from the wise, but fools speak foolishness.

Proverbs 15:4 (NLT) Gentle words are a tree of life; a deceitful tongue crushes the spirit.

Proverbs 15:28 (NLT) The heart of the godly thinks carefully before speaking; the mouth of the wicked overflows with evil words.

Proverbs 16:24 (NLT) Kind words are like honey—sweet to the soul and healthy for the body.

Proverbs 17:27 (NLT) A truly wise person uses few words; a person with understanding is even-tempered.

Proverbs 18:21 (KJV) Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

Proverbs 18:21 (NIV) The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

Proverbs 25:11 (KJV) A word fitly spoken is like apples of gold in pictures of silver.

Proverbs 29:20 (NIV) Do you see someone who speaks in haste? There is more hope for a fool than for them.

Proverbs 31:26 (KJV) She openeth her mouth with wisdom; and in her tongue is the law of kindness.

Matthew 12:34 (NLT) You brood of snakes! How could evil men like you speak what is good and right? For whatever is in your heart determines what you say.

Matthew 12:34 (KJV) O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.

Matthew 12:36-37 (NASB) But I tell you that every careless word that people speak, they shall give an accounting for it in the day of judgment. For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.

Matthew 15:11 (NLT) It's not what goes into your mouth that defiles you; you are defiled by the words that come out of your mouth.

Matthew 15:18 (NASB) But the things that proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and those defile the man.

Mark 11:23 (KJV) For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Romans 4:17 (NLT) That is what the Scriptures mean when God told him, "I have made you the father of many nations." This happened because Abraham believed in the God who brings the dead back to life and who creates new things out of nothing.

Ephesians 4:29 (NLT) Don't use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.

Colossians 3:8 (KJV) But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth.

Colossians 3:16-17 (KJV) Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.

Colossians 4:6 (KJV) Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.

James (whole book)

James 1:26 (NLT) If you claim to be religious but don't control your tongue, you are fooling yourself, and your religion is worthless.

James 3:10 (NLT) And so blessing and cursing come pouring out of the same mouth. Surely, my brothers and sisters, this is not right!

James 3:6 (**KJV**) And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.

1 Peter 3:10 (NLT) For the Scriptures say, "If you want to enjoy life and see many happy days, keep your tongue from speaking evil and your lips from telling lies.
